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Supporting Your Child

Please help your child by making sure they:

- Arrive on time with all belongings clearly labelled.

 - Have a sensible bedtime to be ready for learning.
 - Bring fruit and water for breaktime.
 - Bring a healthy packed lunch (treats only on **Fridays**).
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Homework

- **Times Tables** – practise daily (focus: 3, 4, 8). Use **Times Table Rockstars** or **Hit the Button**.
- **Reading** – 20 minutes every day.
 - Listen to your child read.
 - Ask questions about the book.
 - Sign the reading diary daily.

Online Homework – each week:

- 1 x MyMaths task

- 1 x Reading Eggs task
(Logins are in reading records)
- Homework is set on **Fridays** and due the following **Friday**.

Reading

- Children may take **two books home** (Oxford Reading Tree or library).
- Reading Records must be in school **every day**.
- Adults should sign the Reading Record after each reading session.
- If a child is not reading regularly, we will contact parents to offer support.

Curriculum & Support

- Year 3 will cover the full curriculum in all subjects. You can check the school website and see the whole year Curriculum map.
- Extra small-group support is provided for children who need help in **Reading** and **Maths**.

- Daily **phonics** will continue until the end of **Autumn 1**.
